# ? Chat is TRUTH, and where do you find it?

<u>Studies</u> have shown that only 6% of teenagers believe in truth. Most people don't even know a good definition to describe it. Then you throw in an idea like "Absolute" truth and people really freak out. So, allow me to clarify for you what truth is and how to find it.

#### How to know if your leaders are being led by God:

If you were to do that, you insult the Author of the Bible "God" and call Him a liar. If God created heaven and earth and all that we see, do you also not believe that He is capable of sustaining His holy word to be delivered to us in the exact way He wants it?
- 5. If they become a servant as did Jesus, not seeking the church to serve his needs and desires. (Mark 13:4-17 + Titus 1:7-8)
- 6. If they teach and keep the commandments of God. (Mathew 15:6-9 + Revelation 22:14)

### Fight ways to know you're being deceived:

- 1. A Person is being deceived if he is "a hearer and not a doer" of the word of God. (James 1:23-24)
- 2. A Person is being deceived if he says he has no sin. (1 John 1:8)
- 3. A Person is being deceived when he thinks he is "something when he is nothing." (Galatians 6:3)
- 4. A Person is being deceived when he thinks he is wise with wisdom of this world. (1 Corinthians 3:18)
- 5. A Person is being deceived by seeming to be religious, when an unbridled tongue reveals his true condition. (James 1:26)
- 6. A Person is being deceived if he thinks he will sow and not reap what he sows. (Galatians 6:7)
- 7. A Person is being deceived if he thinks the unrighteous will inherit the kingdom of God.
  - (1 Corinthians 6:9-10)
- 8. A Person is being deceived if he thinks that contact with sin will have no effect on him. (1 Corinthians 15:33)
