

# Escape From Babylon

## The Series Part 15

### Flee From Babylon, You Precious Treasure Of God.

**Fake Christianity** is nothing more than idolatry, with a made-up jESUS as the edifice of their worship. Just like in the days when Jesus walked the earth; the popular, socially acceptable church is on its death bed- powerless to changed the world, content with worldly gain and goods, completely lacking in true riches and wealth, blind, naked, alone, and empty-hearted. It extends its rotten, decaying fingers to a holy God, ever begging for yet another hand-out and blessing of material wealth. The corpse of the “popular” church is wretched, filled with diseases and unclean. We all must flee the houses of spiritual death, shake the dust off our feet and move on to the promise land of God. We must be separate from the world system- IN it as we live here, but not OF it. We are the treasure of God, the very God of the universe. Let us not be like the rebellious children of the world lying to themselves that they know God, when all they know is selfish disobedience and lust for comfort and ease. This is not new, as we read in the following verses:

**(Also Read: Revelation 3:14-22 For Confirmation Of The Dead Last Days Church!)**

**Isaiah 30:1+9-11** “Woe to the rebellious children”, says Yahweh, “who take counsel, but not from me; and who make an alliance, but not with my Spirit, that they may add sin to sin,... For it is a rebellious people, lying children, children who will not hear Yahweh’s law; (10) who tell the seers, “Don’t see!” and to the prophets, “Don’t prophesy to us right things. Tell us pleasant things. Prophecy deceits. (11) Get out of the way. Turn away from the path. Cause the Holy One of Israel to cease from before us.”

**FLEEEEEEE!! RUN FOR YOUR LIFE & YOUR VERY SOUL!**

**Revelation 17:5-6** “And on her forehead a name was written, “MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF THE PROSTITUTES AND OF THE ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.” (6) I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus. When I saw her, I wondered with great amazement.”

**Please note that She is a Mother of Harlots. This means she has had children, daughters go out from her. These are the false churches- denominations of Lucifer, Fake Christianity.**

**Revelation 18:4-6** “I heard another voice from heaven, saying, “Come out of her, my people, that you have no participation in her sins, and that you don’t receive of her plagues, (5) for her sins have reached to the sky, and God has remembered her iniquities. (6) Return to her just as she returned, and repay her double as she did, and according to her works. In the cup which she mixed, mix to her double.”

**Double The Payment: Exodus 22:4; Exodus 22:7; Exodus22:9; Jeremiah 16:18; & Isaiah 40:2**

**2 Corinthians 6:14-18** “Don’t be unequally yoked with unbelievers, for what fellowship have righteousness and iniquity? Or what fellowship has light with darkness? (15) What agreement has Christ with Belial? Or what portion has a believer with an unbeliever? (16) What agreement has a temple of God with idols? For you are a temple of the living God. Even as God said, “I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they will be my people.” (17) Therefore “‘Come out from among them, and be separate,’ says the Lord. ‘Touch no unclean thing. I will receive you. (18) I will be to you a Father. You will be to me sons and daughters,’ says the Lord Almighty.”

### The poet “Mantuanus” expresses this thought well:

*“Ye who desire to live a godly life, depart;  
for, although all things are lawful at Rome, yet to be godly is unlawful.”*

### Example of the duality:

City: **BABYLON**

**Revelation 18:2-3** “He cried with a mighty voice, saying, “Fallen, fallen is Babylon the great, and she has become a habitation of demons, a prison of every unclean spirit, and a prison of every unclean and hateful bird! (3) For all the nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her sexual immorality, the kings of the earth committed sexual immorality with her, and the merchants of the earth grew rich from the abundance of her luxury.”

**Revelation 18:10** “Standing far away for the fear of her torment, saying, ‘Woe, woe, the great city, Babylon, the strong city! For your judgment has come in one hour.’”

City: **NEW JERUSALEM**

**Revelation 21:2-3** “I saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared like a bride adorned for her husband. (3) I heard a loud voice out of heaven saying, “Behold, God’s dwelling is with people, and he will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God.”

## WE COUNT IT ALL LOSS

### As we walk out and leave it all behind

**Philippians 3:7-11** “However, I consider those things that were gain to me as a loss for Christ. (8) Yes most certainly, and I count all things to be a loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus, my Lord, for whom I suffered the loss of all things, and count them nothing but refuse, that I may gain Christ (9) and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own, that which is of the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith; (10) that I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, becoming conformed to his death; (11) if by any means I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.”

## **GOD'S SPECIAL TREASURE**

**1 Peter 2:9-12** “But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people **for God's own possession**, that you may proclaim the excellence of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light: (10) who in time past were no people, but now are God's people, who had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy. (11) Beloved, I beg you as foreigners and pilgrims, to abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; (12) having good behavior among the nations, so in that of which they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they see, glorify God in the day of visitation.”

**Most modern translations lose the plot in this amazing verse:**

**1 Peter 2:9** “and ye are a choice race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people **acquired**, that the excellences ye may shew forth of Him who out of darkness did call you to His wondrous light;” *Young's Literal Translation*

**Acquired; Strong's concordance; G4047 – περιποίησις - peripoiēsis - per-ee-poy'-ay-sis From G4046; acquisition (the act or the thing); by extension preservation: - obtain (-ing), peculiar, purchased, possession, saving.**

**As we see here how the verses connect to this beautiful truth:**

**Acts 20:28** “Take heed, therefore, to yourselves, and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the assembly of the Lord and God which he purchased with his own blood.”

## **PECULIAR PEOPLE**

*We are fools to the world but Treasure to God.*

**Peculiar; Strong's concordance; G4041 – περιούσιος - periousios per-ee-oo'-see-os From the present participle feminine of a compound of G4012 and G1510; being beyond usual, that is, special (one's own): - peculiar.**

**Titus 2:11-15** “For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, (12) teaching us that having denied ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live discreetly, righteously and godly, in this present world, (13) looking for the blessed hope, and the appearance of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, (14) who gave Himself for us that He might redeem us from all iniquity and purify to Himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. (15) Speak these things, and exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no one despise you.”

**What was he referencing here? When He made Israel a nation, they were His peculiar people. Now we the believers of Jesus Christ, Jew and Gentile alike, are His peculiar people being made into one new man in Christ Jesus! Separate From The World!**

**Peculiar; Strong's concordance; H5459 - סְגֻלָּה - segûllâh - seg-ool-law' Feminine passive participle of an unused root meaning to shut up; wealth (as closely shut up): - jewel, peculiar (treasure), proper good, special.**

**Exodus 19:5-6** “And now if you will obey My voice indeed, and keep My covenant, then you shall be a peculiar treasure to Me above all the nations; for all the earth is Mine. (6) And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. These are the words which you shall speak to the sons of Israel.”

**Deuteronomy 14:2** “For you are a holy people to Yahweh your God, and Jehovah has chosen you to be a peculiar people to Himself, above all the nations that are on the earth.”

**Deuteronomy 26:17-19** “You have today said that Jehovah is your God, and that you would walk in His ways, and keep His statutes and His commandments and His judgments, and listen to His voice. (18) And Jehovah has taken you today to be His peculiar people, as He has promised you, and to keep all His commandments, (19) and to make you high above all nations which He has made, in praise and in name and in honor, and that you may be a holy people to Jehovah your God, even as He has spoken.”

**Psalms 135:4-5** “For Yahweh has chosen Jacob to Himself, and Israel for His peculiar treasure. (5) For I know that Yahweh is great, and our LORD is above all gods.”

### **A LIGHT BEFORE HUMANITY**

**Matthew 5:13-16** “You are the salt of the earth, but if the salt has lost its flavor, with what will it be salted? It is then good for nothing, but to be cast out and trodden under the feet of men. (14) You are the light of the world. A city located on a hill can’t be hidden. (15) Neither do you light a lamp, and put it under a measuring basket, but on a stand; and it shines to all who are in the house. (16) Even so, let your light shine before men; that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.”

### **THE WORLD IS NOT WORTHY OF YOU!**

**Hebrews 11:31-40** “By faith, Rahab the prostitute, didn’t perish with those who were disobedient, having received the spies in peace. (32) What more shall I say? For the time would fail me if I told of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, David, Samuel, and the prophets; (33) who, through faith subdued kingdoms, worked out righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, (34) quenched the power of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, from weakness were made strong, grew mighty in war, and caused foreign armies to flee. (35) Women received their dead by resurrection. Others were tortured, not accepting their deliverance, that they might obtain a better resurrection. (36) Others were tried by mocking and scourging, yes, moreover by bonds and imprisonment. (37) They were stoned. They were sawn apart. They were tempted. They were slain with the sword. They went around in sheep skins and in goat skins; being destitute, afflicted, ill-treated (38) (of whom the world was not worthy), wandering in deserts, mountains, caves, and the holes of the earth. (39) These all, having had testimony given to them through their faith, didn’t receive the promise, (40) God having provided some better thing concerning us, so that apart from us they should not be made perfect.”

## **WALK WORTHY OF THE ONE WHO CALLED YOU!**

**Ephesians 4:1-7** “I therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, beg you to walk worthily of the calling with which you were called, (2) with all lowliness and humility, with patience, bearing with one another in love; (3) being eager to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. (4) There is one body, and one Spirit, even as you also were called in one hope of your calling; (5) one Lord, one faith, one baptism, (6) one God and Father of all, who is over all, and through all, and in us all. (7) But to each one of us was the grace given according to the measure of the gift of Christ.”

**Colossians 1:9-14** “For this cause we also, since the day we heard, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that you might be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding, that you might walk worthy of the Lord to all pleasing, being fruitful in every work and increasing in the knowledge of God, being empowered with all power, according to the might of His glory, to all patience and long-suffering with joyfulness, giving thanks to the Father, who has made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light. For He has delivered us from the power of darkness and has translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son; in whom we have redemption through His blood, the remission of sins.”

**1 Thessalonians 2:10-12** “You and God are witnesses how holily and justly and blamelessly we were to you who believe, even as you know how we exhorted and comforted and testified to each one of you, as a father to his children, that you should walk worthy of God, who has called you to His kingdom and glory.”

**Revelation 3:4-5** “Nevertheless you have a few names in Sardis that didn’t defile their garments. They will walk with me in white, for they are worthy. (5) He who overcomes will be arrayed in white garments, and I will in no way blot his name out of the book of life, and I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.”

**Luke 21:31-36** “Even so you also, when you see these things happening, know that God’s Kingdom is near. (32) Most certainly I tell you, this generation will not pass away until all things are accomplished. (33) Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will by no means pass away. (34) “So be careful, or your hearts will be loaded down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that day will come on you suddenly. (35) For it will come like a snare on all those who dwell on the surface of all the earth. (36) Therefore be watchful all the time, praying that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will happen, and to stand before the Son of Man.”

**2 Thessalonians 1:11-12** “To this end we also pray always for you, that our God may count you worthy of your calling, and fulfill every desire of goodness and work of faith, with power; (12) that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.”

## **FOR THE TRUE BELIEVER THERE IS NO OTHER WAY.**

**John 6:27-29** “Don’t work for the food which perishes, but for the food which remains to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you. For God the Father has sealed him.”

(28) They said therefore to him, “What must we do, that we may work the works of God?”

(29) Jesus answered them, “This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent.”

**Matthew 6:25-34** “Therefore I tell you, don’t be anxious for your life: what you will eat, or what you will drink; nor yet for your body, what you will wear. Isn’t life more than food, and the body more than clothing? (26) See the birds of the sky, that they don’t sow, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns. Your heavenly Father feeds them. Aren’t you of much more value than they? (27) “Which of you, by being anxious, can add one moment to his lifespan? (28) Why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow. They don’t toil, neither do they spin, (29) yet I tell you that even Solomon in all his glory was not dressed like one of these. (30) But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today exists, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, won’t he much more clothe you, you of little faith? (31) “Therefore don’t be anxious, saying, ‘What will we eat?’, ‘What will we drink?’ or, ‘With what will we be clothed?’ (32) For the Gentiles seek after all these things; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. (33) But seek first God’s Kingdom, and his righteousness; and all these things will be given to you as well. (34) Therefore don’t be anxious for tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Each day’s own evil is sufficient.”

## **BRACE FOR IMPACT**

**Matthew 10:34-39** “Don’t think that I came to send peace on the earth. I didn’t come to send peace, but a sword. (35) For I came to set a man at odds against his father, and a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law. (36) A man’s foes will be those of his own household. (37) He who loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; and he who loves son or daughter more than me isn’t worthy of me. (38) He who doesn’t take his cross and follow after me, isn’t worthy of me. (39) He who seeks his life will lose it; and he who loses his life for my sake will find it.”

### When You Become Special To God, You Often Become Important To The Devil!

**Acts 14:22** “They strengthened the souls of the disciples and encouraged them to continue in the faith, saying, “We must enter the kingdom of God through many persecutions.”

**1 Thessalonians 3:4** “For most certainly, when we were with you, we told you beforehand that we are to suffer affliction, even as it happened, and you know.”

**John 15:18-21** “If the world hates you, you know that it has hated me before it hated you. (19) If you were of the world, the world would love its own. **But because you are not of the world, since I chose you out of the world,** therefore the world hates you. (20) Remember the word that I said to you: ‘A servant is not greater than his lord.’ If they persecuted me, they will also persecute you. If they kept my word, they will also keep yours. (21) But they will do all these things to you for my name’s sake, because they don’t know him who sent me.”

**Matthew 5:10-12** “Blessed are those who have been persecuted for righteousness’ sake, for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven. (11) “Blessed are you when people reproach you, persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely, for my sake. (12) **Rejoice, and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven.** For that is how they persecuted the prophets who were before you.”

**John 16:33** “I have told you these things so that in me you may have peace. In the world you have trouble and suffering, but **take courage – I have conquered the world.**”

**Revelation 2:10** “Do not be afraid of the things you are about to suffer. The devil is about to have some of you thrown into prison so you may be tested, and you will experience suffering for ten days. Remain faithful even to the point of death, **and I will give you the crown that is life itself.**”

**Revelation 7:14-17** “So I said to him, “My lord, you know the answer.” Then he said to me, “These are the ones who have come out of the great tribulation. They have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb! (15) **For this reason they are before the throne of God, and they serve him day and night in his temple, and the one seated on the throne will shelter them. (16) They will never go hungry or be thirsty again, and the sun will not beat down on them, nor any burning heat, (17) because the Lamb in the middle of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to springs of living water, and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.**”

*~Be Of Good Cheer~*

**Romans 5:3-5** “Not only this, but we also rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces perseverance; (4) and perseverance, proven character; and proven character, hope: (5) and hope doesn’t disappoint us, because God’s love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.”

**Romans 8:35-39** “Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Could oppression, or anguish, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? (36) Even as it is written, “For your sake we are killed all day long. We were accounted as sheep for the slaughter.” (37) No, in all these things, we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. (38) For I am persuaded that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, (39) nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from God’s love, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

**Romans 12:9-21** “Love must be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil, cling to what is good. (10) Be devoted to one another with mutual love, showing eagerness in honoring one another. (11) Do not lag in zeal, be enthusiastic in spirit, serve the Lord. (12) Rejoice in hope, endure in suffering, persist in prayer. (13) Contribute to the needs of the saints, pursue hospitality. (14) Bless those who persecute you, bless and do not curse. (15) Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep. (16) Live in harmony with one another; do not be haughty but associate with the lowly. Do not be conceited. (17) Do not repay anyone evil for evil; consider what is good before all people. (18) If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all people. (19) Do not avenge yourselves, dear friends, but give place to God’s wrath, for it is written, “Vengeance is mine, I will repay,” says the Lord. (20) Rather, if your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in doing this you will be heaping burning coals on his head. (21) Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.”

**GOD WILL REPAY THE WICKED FOR WHAT THEY DO.**

**Jeremiah 17:18** “Let them be disappointed who persecute me, but let not me be disappointed. Let them be dismayed, but don’t let me be dismayed. Bring on them the day of evil, and destroy them with double destruction.” Just Like **Revelation 18:4-6**

**2 Thessalonians 1:5-12** “This is an obvious sign of the righteous judgment of God, to the end that you may be counted worthy of God’s Kingdom, for which you also suffer. (6) Since it is a righteous thing with God to repay affliction to those who afflict you, (7) and to give relief to you who are afflicted with us, when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with his mighty angels in flaming fire, (8) punishing those who don’t know God, and to those who don’t obey the Good News of our Lord Jesus, (9) who will pay the penalty: eternal destruction from the face of the Lord and from the glory of his might, (10) when he comes in that day to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired among all those who have believed, because our testimony to you was believed. (11) To this end we also pray always for you, that our God may count you worthy of your calling, and fulfill every desire of goodness and work of faith, with power; (12) that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.”

**Romans 2:5-11** “But according to your hardness and unrepentant heart you are treasuring up for yourself wrath in the day of wrath, revelation, and of the righteous judgment of God; (6) who “will pay back to everyone according to their works:” (7) to those who by perseverance in well-doing seek for glory, honor, and incorruptibility, eternal life; (8) but to those who are self-seeking, and don’t obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, will be wrath and indignation, (9) oppression and anguish, on every soul of man who does evil, to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. (10) But glory, honor, and peace go to every man who does good, to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. (11) For there is no partiality with God.”
