

-Weapons Of Warfare Part I -

When the world denies Jesus, it's for a good reason. Satan knows the power of Christ and what His precious blood has accomplished for humanity. The first one we can forgive and train up those individuals to reveal the hidden knowledge of the facts. As it seems, many churches stay away from this topic. The second ones must be dealt with swiftly and directly. They have to be exposed for all to see. I hope to do just that with this Bible study on the Blood of Jesus. Allow me to demonstrate the foolishness of Satan and his followers and embarrass them publicly for their rebellion and error! We will build our faith and understand at the same time the miracle of the blood of Jesus.

<u>The Situation</u>

Romans 5:12–15 "Therefore as sin entered into the world through one man, and death through sin; so death passed to all men, because all sinned. (13) For until the law, sin was in the world; but sin is not charged when there is no law. (14) Nevertheless death reigned from Adam until Moses, even over those whose sins weren't like Adam's disobedience, who is a foreshadowing of him who was to come. (15) But the free gift isn't like the trespass. For if by the trespass of the one the many died, much more did the grace of God, and the gift by the grace of the one man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many."

I John 3:4 "Everyone who sins also commits lawlessness. Sin is lawlessness."

Ecclesiastes 12:13–14 "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter. Fear God, and keep His commandments. For this is the whole duty of man. (14) For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it is good, or whether evil."

The Plan & The Power Of The Blood

Hebrews 9:19–2.2 "For when every commandment had been spoken by Moses to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of the calves and the goats, with water and scarlet wool and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book itself and all the people, (20) saying, "This is the blood of the covenant which God has commanded you." (21) Moreover he sprinkled the tabernacle and all the vessels of the ministry in the same way with the blood. (22) According to the law, nearly everything is cleansed with blood, and apart from shedding of blood there is no remission."

The Failed Blood Of Animals

Hebrews IO:1-6 "For the law, having a shadow of the good to come, not the very image of the things, can never with the same sacrifices year by year, which they offer continually, make perfect those who draw near. (2) Or else wouldn't they have ceased to be offered, because the worshipers, having been once cleansed, would have had no more consciousness of sins? (3) But in those sacrifices there is a yearly reminder of sins. (4) For it is impossible that the **blood** of bulls and goats should take away sins. (5) Therefore when he comes into the world, he says, "Sacrifice and offering you didn't desire, but you prepared a body for me. (6) You had no pleasure in whole burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin."

Revelation 5:9–IO "They sang a new song, saying, "You are worthy to take the book, and to open its seals: for you were killed, and **bought** us for God with your **blood**, out of every tribe, language, people, and nation, (10) and made us kings and priests to our God, and we will reign on the earth."

I John 1:5-7 "This is the message which we have heard from him and announce to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. (6) If we say that we have fellowship with him and walk in the darkness, we lie, and don't tell the truth. (7) But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the **blood** of Jesus Christ, his Son, **cleanses** us from all sin."

Revelation 12:10–II "I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, "Now the salvation, the power, and the Kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Christ has come; for the accuser of our brothers has been thrown down, who accuses them before our God day and night. (11) They **overcame** him because of the Lamb's **blood**, and because of the word of their testimony. They didn't love their life, even to death."

The Execution Of Perfection

Hebrews IO:15-23 "The Holy Spirit also testifies to us, for after saying, (16) "This is the covenant that I will make with them: 'After those days,' says the Lord, 'I will put my laws on their heart, I will also write them on their mind;'" then he says, (17) "I will remember their sins and their iniquities no more." (18) Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin. (19) Having therefore, brothers, boldness to enter into the holy place by the **blood** of Jesus, (20) by the way which he dedicated for us, a new and living way, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; (21) and having a great priest over God's house, (22) let's draw near with a true heart in fullness of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and having our body washed with pure water, (23) let's hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering; for he who promised is faithful."

Hebrews 9:24–28 "For Christ hasn't entered into holy places made with hands, which are representations of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us; (25) nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest enters into the holy place year by year with blood not his own, (26) or else he must have suffered often since the foundation of the world. But now once at the end of the ages, he has been revealed to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself. (27) Inasmuch as it is appointed for men to die once, and after this, judgment, (28) so Christ also, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, without sin, to those who are eagerly waiting for him for salvation."

Romans 3:21-26 "But now apart from the law, a righteousness of God has been revealed, being testified by the law and the prophets; (22) even the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ to all and on all those who believe. For there is no distinction, (23) for all have sinned, and fall short of the glory of God; (24) being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus; (25) whom God sent to be an atoning sacrifice, through faith in his **blood**, for a demonstration of his righteousness at this present time; that he might himself be just, and the justifier of him who has faith in Jesus."

Eppesians 2:II-IO "Therefore remember that once you, the Gentiles in the flesh, who are called "uncircumcision" by that which is called "circumcision", (in the flesh, made by hands); (12) that you were at that time separate from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of the promise, having no hope and without God in the world. (13) But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off are made near in the **blood** of Christ. (14) For he is our peace, who made both one, and broke down the middle wall of partition, (15) having abolished in his flesh the hostility, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, that he might create in himself one new man of the two, making peace; (16) and might reconcile them both in one body to God through the cross, having killed the hostility thereby."

Revelation 1:4–6 "John, to the seven assemblies that are in Asia: Grace to you and peace, from God, who is and who was and who is to come; and from the seven Spirits who are before his throne; (5) and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To him who loves us, and washed us from our sins by his **blood**; (6) and he made us to be a Kingdom, priests to his God and Father; to him be the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen."

How To Contact Jesus' Saving Blood

Now that we know the power and benefits of the blood, let's go over how to utilize the precious Blood of Jesus.

Belief, Confession, Repentance & Baptism

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish, but have eternal life." John 3:16

Romans IO:9–IO "That if you will confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. (10) For with the heart, one believes unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation."

I John I:5-IO "This is the message which we have heard from him and announce to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. (6) If we say that we have fellowship with him and walk in the darkness, we lie, and don't tell the truth. (7) But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ, his Son, cleanses us from all sin. (8) If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. (9) If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous to forgive us the sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (10) If we say that we haven't sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us."

Luke 13:3-5 "I tell you, no, but unless you repent, you will all perish in the same way. (4) Or those eighteen, on whom the tower in Siloam fell, and killed them; do you think that they were worse offenders than all the men who dwell in Jerusalem? (5) I tell you, no, but, unless you repent, you will all perish in the same way."

Acts 2:38 "Peter said to them, "Repent, and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

Acts 2.2:16 "Now why do you wait? Arise, be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord."

Then Receive The Full Benefits Of The Blood Of Jesus By Receiving Salvation!

Recap: No Jesus=No Blood=No Salvation

John 6:67–68 "Jesus said therefore to the twelve, "You don't also want to go away, do you?" (68) Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom would we go? You have the words of eternal life."

John 14:6 "Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father, except through me."

Acts 20:28 "Take heed, therefore, to yourselves, and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the assembly of the Lord and God which he purchased with his own blood."

- > His Blood is the foundation for a relationship with the Father.
- His perfect, sinless life has allowed the full blessing and coverage of the Father upon us.
- We therefore are not dealt with by God by our own sinfulness, but Jesus' righteousness. Demonstrated in His perfect, sinless life.

Romans 8:14–17 "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are children of God. (15) For you didn't receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" (16) The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God; (17) and if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint heirs with Christ; if indeed we suffer with him, that we may also be glorified with him."

Galatians 3:26–29 "For you are all children of God, through faith in Christ Jesus. (27) For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. (28) There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus. (29) If you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring and heirs according to promise." **Galatians 4:6-7** "And because you are children, God sent out the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, "Abba, Father!" (7) So you are no longer a bondservant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ."

I John 3:1-3 "See how great a love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God! For this cause the world doesn't know us, because it didn't know him.
(2) Beloved, now we are children of God, and it is not yet revealed what we will be. But we know that when he is revealed, we will be like him; for we will see him just as he is.
(3) Everyone who has this hope set on him purifies himself, even as he is pure."

Now We Speak With The Authority Of Jesus

Eppesians I:20–23 "Which he worked in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and made him to sit at his right hand in the heavenly places, (21) far above all rule, and authority, and power, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age, but also in that which is to come. (22) He put all things in subjection under his feet, and gave him to be head over all things for the assembly, (23) which is his body, the fullness of him who fills all in all."

Philippians 2:9–II "Therefore God also highly exalted him, and gave to him the name which is above every name; (10) that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, those on earth, and those under the earth, (11) and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."

Matthew 28:18–20 "Jesus came to them and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to me in heaven and on earth. (19) Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, (20) teaching them to observe all things that I commanded you. Behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Mark 16:15–18 "He said to them, "Go into all the world, and preach the Good News to the whole creation. (16) He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who disbelieves will be condemned. (17) These signs will accompany those who believe: in my name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new languages; (18) they will take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it will in no way hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

> This is why we cast out demons by the Blood of Jesus Christ.

Conclusion

I Peter I:I7-2.1 "If you call on him as Father, who without respect of persons judges according to each man's work, pass the time of your living as foreigners here in reverent fear: (18) knowing that you were redeemed, not with corruptible things, with silver or

gold, from the useless way of life handed down from your fathers, (19) but with precious **blood**, as of a lamb without blemish or spot, the blood of Christ; (20) who was foreknown indeed before the foundation of the world, but was revealed in this last age for your sake, (21) who through him are believers in God, who raised him from the dead, and gave him glory; so that your faith and hope might be in God."

Now Love Like He Has & Do For Others What He Did

John 13:31–35 "When he had gone out, Jesus said, "Now the Son of Man has been glorified, and God has been glorified in him. (32) If God has been glorified in him, God will also glorify him in himself, and he will glorify him immediately. (33) Little children, I will be with you a little while longer. You will seek me, and as I said to the Jews, 'Where I am going, you can't come,' so now I tell you. (34) A new commandment I give to you, that you **love one another**. Just as I have loved you, you also love one another. (35) By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

John 15:8–14 "In this is my Father glorified, that you bear much fruit; and so you will be my disciples. (9) Even as the Father has loved me, I also have loved you. Remain in my love. (10) If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and remain in his love. (11) I have spoken these things to you, that my joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be made full. (12) "This is my commandment, that you **love one another**, even as I have loved you. (13) Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends. (14) You are my friends, if you do whatever I command you."

Will you love God so much and be such an obedient follower of Jesus, that you would be willing to spill your own blood for your brothers and sisters in Christ? Now, I speak spiritually through sacrifice of one's life, yet maybe one day, literally.

John IO:I4–I5 "I am the good shepherd. I know my own, and I'm known by my own; (15) even as the Father knows me, and I know the Father. I lay down my life for the sheep."

Mark 8:34–38 "He called the multitude to himself with his disciples, and said to them, "Whoever wants to come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. (35) For whoever wants to save his life will lose it; and whoever will lose his life for my sake and the sake of the Good News will save it. (36) For what does it profit a man, to gain the whole world, and forfeit his life? (37) For what will a man give in exchange for his life? (38) For whoever will be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man also will be ashamed of him, when he comes in his Father's glory, with the holy angels."
