## PRAY THESE DAILY

### ● Remember Me

**Psalms 106:4-5** “Remember me, Yahweh, with the favor that you show to your people. Visit me with your salvation, (5) that I may see the prosperity of your chosen, that I may rejoice in the gladness of your nation, that I may glory with your inheritance.”

**Isaiah 49:15-16** “Can a woman forget her nursing child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? Yes, these may forget, yet I will not forget you! (16) Behold, I have engraved you on the palms of my hands. your walls are continually before me.”

**Also Read: Psalms 25**

### ● Uphold Us

**Isaiah 41:10** “Do not be afraid, for I am with you. Do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you. Yes, I will help you. Yes, I will uphold you with the right hand of my righteousness.”

## ● Give Us Your Peace

**John 14:27** “Peace I leave with you. My peace I give to you; not as the world gives, give I to you. Don’t let your heart be troubled, neither let it be fearful.”

## ● Pray To Escape What Is Coming And Stand Before You.

**Luke 21:34-36** “So be careful, or your hearts will be loaded down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that day will come on you suddenly. (35) For it will come like a snare on all those who dwell on the surface of all the earth. (36) Therefore be watchful all the time, praying that you may be **counted worthy to escape** all these things that will happen, and **to stand before** the Son of Man.”

## ● Pray That God Protects You From The Devil

**John 17:15** “I pray not that you would take them from the world, but that you would keep them from the evil one.”

**Luke 11:2-4** “And He said to them, When you pray, say: Our Father, who is in Heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come, Your will be done, as in Heaven, so also on the earth. (3) Give us day by day our daily bread, (4) and forgive us our sins, for we ourselves also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.”

### ➤ Key Ingredient For Protection

**Hosea 4:6** “My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I will also reject you, that you may be no priest to me. Because you have forgotten your God’s law, I will also forget your children.”

## ● Show Us Great And Mysterious Things

**Jeremiah 33:2-3** “I, the LORD, do these things. I, the LORD, form the plan to bring them about. I am known as the LORD. I say to you, (3) ‘Call on me in prayer and I will answer you. I will show you great and mysterious things which you still do not know about.’”

## ● Show Us What You Will Do

**Amos 3:7** “Surely the Lord Yahweh will do nothing, unless he reveals his secret to his servants the prophets.”

**John 15:15** “No longer do I call you servants, for the servant doesn’t know what his lord does. But I have called you friends, for everything that I heard from my Father, I have made known to you.”

## **Show Us The Mysteries Of Your Kingdom**

**Luke 8:10** “He said, “To you it is given to know the mysteries of God’s Kingdom, but to the rest in parables; that ‘seeing they may not see, and hearing they may not understand.’”

## **Give Us Wisdom**

**James 1:5-8** “But if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach; and it will be given to him. (6) But let him ask in faith, without any doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, driven by the wind and tossed. (7) For that man shouldn’t think that he will receive anything from the Lord. (8) He is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.”

**Proverbs 4:5-9** “Get wisdom. Get understanding. Don’t forget, and don’t deviate from the words of my mouth. (6) Don’t forsake her, and she will preserve you. Love her, and she will keep you. (7) Wisdom is supreme. Get wisdom. Yes, though it costs all your possessions, get understanding. (8) Esteem her, and she will exalt you. She will bring you to honor, when you embrace her. (9) She will give to your head a garland of grace. She will deliver a crown of splendor to you.”

## **Holy Spirit Teach Us And Remind Us Of Jesus**

**John 14:26** “But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things, and will remind you of all that I said to you.”

**John 15:26-27** “When the Counselor has come, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will testify about me. (27) You will also testify, because you have been with me from the beginning.”

## **Help Us To Remain A Part Of The Vine Of Jesus**

**John 15:1-11** “I am the true vine, and my Father is the farmer. (2) Every branch in me that doesn’t bear fruit, he takes away. Every branch that bears fruit, he prunes, that it may bear more fruit. (3) You are already pruned clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. (4) Remain in me, and I in you. As the branch can’t bear fruit by itself, unless it remains in the vine, so neither can you, unless you remain in me. (5) I am the vine. You are the branches. He who remains in me, and I in him, the same bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. (6) If a man doesn’t remain in me, he is thrown out as a branch, and is withered; and they gather them, throw them into the fire, and they are burned. (7) If you remain in me, and my words remain in you, you will ask whatever you desire, and it will be done for you. (8) “In this is my Father glorified, that you bear much fruit; and so you will be my disciples. (9) Even as the Father has loved me, I also have loved you. Remain in my love. (10) If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love; even as I have kept my Father’s commandments, and remain in his love. (11) I have spoken these things to you, that my joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be made full.”

➤ **Why Is This So Important?**

**John 16:27** “The Father loves you because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God.”

➤ **How Do We Love Jesus So That We Can Remain In God’s Love?**

**John 14:15** “If you love me, keep my commandments. “

**John 14:23-24** “Jesus answered him, “If a man loves me, he will keep my word. My Father will love him, and we will come to him, and make our home with him. (24) He who doesn’t love me doesn’t keep my words. The word which you hear isn’t mine, but the Father’s who sent me.”

**We cannot bear fruit for the kingdom or remain connected to the vine of Jesus if we do not obey Jesus, and in turn, obey God. By doing so, we remain in their love!**

● **Send Workers Into The Harvest**

**Luke 10:2** “He told them, “The harvest is large, but the workers are few. So ask the Lord who gives this harvest to send workers to harvest his crops.”

● **Strength To Work While It Is Day**

**John 9:4** “We must do what the one who sent me wants us to do while it is day. The night when no one can do anything is coming.”

## REMEMBER THESE DAILY

● **Remember God**

**Psalms 9:16-17** “Yahweh has made himself known. He has executed judgment. The wicked is snared by the work of his own hands. Meditation. Selah. (17) The wicked shall be turned back to Hell, even all the nations that forget God.”

● **Remember The Works Of God**

**Psalms 78:1-8** “Hear my teaching, my people. Turn your ears to the words of my mouth. (2) I will open my mouth in a parable. I will utter dark sayings of old, (3) Which we have heard and known, and our fathers have told us. (4) We will not hide them from their children, telling to the generation to come the praises of Yahweh, his strength, and his wondrous deeds that he has done. (5) For he established a testimony in Jacob, and appointed a teaching in Israel, which he commanded our fathers, that they should make them known to their children; (6) that the generation to come might know, even the children who should be born; who should arise and tell their children, (7) that they might set their hope in God, and not forget God’s deeds, but keep his commandments, (8) and might not be as their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation, a generation that didn’t make their hearts loyal, whose spirit was not steadfast with God.”

**Psalms 105:1-5** “Give thanks to Yahweh! Call on his name! Make his doings known among the peoples. (2) Sing to him, sing praises to him! Tell of all his marvelous works. (3) Glory in his holy name. Let the heart of those who seek Yahweh rejoice. (4) Seek Yahweh and his strength. Seek his face forever more. (5) Remember his marvelous works that he has done; his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth,”

### ● Remember God’s Mercy And Grace

**Psalms 103:1-5** “Praise the LORD, O my soul! With all that is within me, praise his holy name! (2) Praise the LORD, O my soul! Do not forget all his kind deeds! (3) He is the one who forgives all your sins, who heals all your diseases, (4) who delivers your life from the Pit, who crowns you with his loyal love and compassion, (5) who satisfies your life with good things, so your youth is renewed like an eagle’s.”

### ● Remember God’s Special Day

**Exodus 20:8-11** “Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. (9) You shall labor six days, and do all your work, (10) but the seventh day is a Sabbath to Yahweh your God. You shall not do any work in it, you, nor your son, nor your daughter, your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your livestock, nor your stranger who is within your gates; (11) for in six days Yahweh made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day; therefore Yahweh blessed the Sabbath day, and made it holy.”

**Isaiah 58:13-14** “If you turn away your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on my holy day; and call the Sabbath a delight, and the holy of Yahweh honorable; and shall honor it, not doing your own ways, nor finding your own pleasure, nor speaking your own words: (14) then you shall delight yourself in Yahweh; and I will make you to ride on the high places of the earth; and I will feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father:” for Yahweh’s mouth has spoken it.”

### ● Remember God’s Laws and Commands

**Psalms 119:17-20** “Do good to your servant. I will live and I will obey your word. (18) Open my eyes, that I may see wondrous things out of your law. (19) I am a stranger on the earth. Don’t hide your commandments from me. (20) My soul is consumed with longing for your ordinances at all times.”

**Read: All Of Psalms 119**

**Proverbs 6:20-23** “My son, keep your father’s commandment, and don’t forsake your mother’s teaching. (21) Bind them continually on your heart. Tie them around your neck. (22) When you walk, it will lead you. When you sleep, it will watch over you. When you awake, it will talk with you. (23) For the commandment is a lamp, and the law is light. Reproofs of instruction are the way of life,”

**Psalms 119:9-16** “How can a young man keep his way pure? By living according to your word. (10) With my whole heart, I have sought you. Don’t let me wander from your commandments. (11) I have hidden your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you. (12) Blessed are you, Yahweh. Teach me your statutes. (13) With my lips, I have declared all the ordinances of your mouth. (14) I have rejoiced in the way of your testimonies, as much as in all riches. (15) I will meditate on your precepts, and consider your ways. (16) I will delight myself in your statutes. I will not forget your word.”

**Numbers 15:39-40** “You must have this tassel so that you may look at it and remember all the commandments of the LORD and obey them and so that you do not follow after your own heart and your own eyes that lead you to unfaithfulness. (40) Thus you will remember and obey all my commandments and be holy to your God.”

**Psalms 103:17-19** “But the LORD continually shows loyal love to his faithful followers, and is faithful to their descendants, (18) to those who keep his covenant, who are careful to obey his commands. (19) The LORD has established his throne in heaven; his kingdom extends over everything.”

### ● Remember That It Is God Who Prospers You

**Deuteronomy 8:17-20** “Be careful not to say, “My own ability and skill have gotten me this wealth.” (18) You must remember the LORD your God, for he is the one who gives ability to get wealth; if you do this he will confirm his covenant that he made by oath to your ancestors, even as he has to this day. (19) Now if you forget the LORD your God at all and follow other gods, worshiping and prostrating yourselves before them, I testify to you today that you will surely be annihilated. (20) Just like the nations the LORD is about to destroy from your sight, so he will do to you because you would not obey him.”

### ● Remember What Jesus Told You And Follow His Example

**John 16:4** “But I have told you these things, so that when the time comes, you may remember that I told you about them. I didn’t tell you these things from the beginning, because I was with you.”

**1 Peter 2:21-23** “For to this you were called, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving an example for you to follow in his steps. (22) He committed no sin nor was deceit found in his mouth. (23) When he was maligned, he did not answer back; when he suffered, he threatened no retaliation, but committed himself to God who judges justly.”

**John 15:18-25** “If the world hates you, you know that it has hated me before it hated you. (19) If you were of the world, the world would love its own. But because you are not of the world, since I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you. (20) Remember the word that I said to you: ‘A servant is not greater than his lord.’ If they persecuted me, they will also persecute you. If they kept my word, they will also keep yours. (21) But they will do all these things to you for my name’s sake, because they don’t know him who sent me. (22) If I had not come and spoken to them, they would not have had sin; but now they have no excuse for their sin. (23) He who hates me, hates my Father also. (24) If I hadn’t done among them the works which no one else did, they wouldn’t have had sin. But now they have seen and also hated both me and my Father. (25) But this happened so that the word may be fulfilled which was written in their law, ‘They hated me without a cause.’”

### ● Remember The Truth Given You

**Revelation 3:2-3** “Wake up then, and strengthen what remains that was about to die, because I have not found your deeds complete in the sight of my God. (3) Therefore, remember what you received and heard, and obey it, and repent. If you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will never know at what hour I will come against you.”

### ● Remember Those Who Have Taught You

**1 Corinthians 11:2** “Now I praise you, brothers, that you remember me in all things, and hold firm the traditions, even as I delivered them to you.”

**Hebrews 13:7** “Remember your leaders, who spoke God’s message to you; reflect on the outcome of their lives and imitate their faith.”

**Hebrews 13:17** “Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they keep watch over your souls and will give an account for their work. Let them do this with joy and not with complaints, for this would be no advantage for you.”

### ● Love Each Other And Remember The Persecuted Church

**Hebrews 13:1-3** “Brotherly love must continue. (2) Do not neglect hospitality, because through it some have entertained angels without knowing it. (3) Remember those in prison as though you were in prison with them, and those ill-treated as though you too felt their torment.”

## ● Remember Your First Works

**Revelation 2:5** “Therefore, remember from what high state you have fallen and repent! Do the deeds you did at the first; if not, I will come to you and remove your lamp stand from its place – that is, if you do not repent.”

Let us go back over these “Daily Prayer Points and Remembrance” every day until we have memorized the outline. Hide the words of God in your heart and then you will never be without the encouragement we all need to make it home. Like all things in life, it takes work and commitment to be successful to the goal at hand. Walking with God is no different. Equip yourselves for the ultimate victory in life: **Faithfulness to Jesus!**
