<u>REVELATION 22:12–14</u> "Behold, I come quickly. My reward is with me, to repay to each man according to his work. (13) I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End. (14) Blessed are those who do his commandments, that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter in by the gates into the city."

ROMANS 2:4–11 "Or do you despise the riches of his goodness, forbearance, and patience, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance? (5) But according to your hardness and unrepentant heart you are treasuring up for yourself wrath in the day of wrath, revelation, and of the righteous judgment of God; (6) who "will pay back to everyone according to their works:" (7) to those who by perseverance in well-doing seek for glory, honor, and incorruptibility, eternal life; (8) but to those who are self-seeking, and don't obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, will be wrath and indignation, (9) oppression and anguish, on every soul of man who does evil, to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. STEP 7 - WARNINGS FOR THOSE WHO LONG FOR EARTHLY RICHES

1 SAMUEL 2:6–10 "Yahweh kills, and makes alive. He brings down to Sheol, and brings up. (7) Yahweh makes poor, and makes rich. He brings low, he also lifts up. (8) He raises up the poor out of the dust. He lifts up the needy from the dunghill, To make them sit with princes, and inherit the throne of glory. For the pillars of the earth are Yahweh's. He has set the world on them. (9) He will keep the feet of his holy ones, but the wicked shall be put to silence in darkness; for no man shall prevail by strength. (10) Those who strive with Yahweh shall be broken to pieces. He will thunder against them in the sky. "Yahweh will judge the ends of the earth. He will give strength to his king, and exalt the horn of his anointed."

Aren't you of much more value than they? (27) "Which of you, by being anxious, can add one moment to his lifespan? (28) Why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow. They don't toil, neither do they spin, (29) yet I tell you that even Solomon in all his glory was not dressed like one of these. (30) But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today exists, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, won't he much more clothe you, you of little faith? (31) "Therefore don't be anxious, saying, 'What will we eat?', 'What will we drink?' or, 'With what will we be clothed?' (32) For the Gentiles seek after all these things; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. (33) But seek first God's Kingdom, and his righteousness; and all these things will be given to you as well. (34) Therefore don't be anxious for tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Each day's own evil is sufficient."

<u>1 TIMOTHY 6:6–10</u> "But godliness with contentment is great gain. (7) For we brought nothing into the world, and we certainly can't carry anything out. (8) But having food and clothing, we will be content with that. (9) But those who are determined to be rich fall into a temptation and a snare and many foolish and harmful lusts, such as drown men in ruin and destruction. (10) For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some have been led astray from the faith in their greed, and have pierced themselves through with many sorrows."

<u>PROVERBS 28:6</u> "Better is the poor who walks in his integrity, than he who is perverse in his ways, and he is rich."

<u>PROVERBS 28:20</u> "A faithful man is rich with blessings; but one who is eager to be rich will not go unpunished."

<u>PROVERBS 28:22</u> "A stingy man hurries after riches, and **doesn't know that poverty** waits for him."

<u>ECCLESIASTES 5:12</u> "The sleep of a laboring man is sweet, whether he eats little or much; but the abundance of the rich will not allow him to sleep."

(17) Because you say, 'I am rich, and have gotten riches, and have need of nothing;' and don't know that you are the wretched one, miserable, poor, blind, and naked; (18) I counsel you to buy from me gold refined by fire, that you may become rich; and white garments, that you may clothe yourself, and that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and eye salve to anoint your eyes, that you may see. (19) As many as I love, I reprove and chasten. Be zealous therefore, and repent."

<u>1 TIMOTHY 6:17–19</u> "Charge those who are rich in this present world that they not be arrogant, nor have their hope set on the uncertainty of riches, but on the living God, who richly provides us with everything to enjoy; (18) that they do good, that they be rich in good works, that they be ready to distribute, willing to share; (19) laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold of eternal life."

<u>PROVERBS 30:7–9</u> "Two things I have asked of you; don't deny me before I die: (8) Remove far from me falsehood and lies. **Give me neither poverty nor riches.** Feed me with the food that is needful for me; (9) lest I be full, deny you, and say, 'Who is Yahweh?' or lest I be poor, and steal, and so dishonor the name of my God.

<u>JEREMIAH 9:23–24</u> "Yahweh says, "Don't let the wise man glory in his wisdom. Don't let the mighty man glory in his might. **Don't let the rich man glory in his riches.** (24) But **let him who glories glory in this, that he has understanding, and knows me**, that I am Yahweh who exercises loving kindness, justice, and righteousness, in the earth; for I delight in these things," says Yahweh."

As we can clearly see, God wants us all to be rich beyond our imaginations. Yet, what the world declares are riches and are worth having, the God that already owns everything laughs at the petty attempt to accumulate what is already owned by Him.
